Post Your OSHA Form 300 A Summary Data by February 1st, 2019

February 1st, 2019 marks the deadline for you to tabulate your annual OSHA 300 A Summary of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses and post it in a common area wherever notices to employees are usually posted.

The summary must list the total number of job-related injuries and illnesses that occurred during the previous calendar year and were logged on the OSHA 300 Form for each location. The Summary must stay posted until at least April 30th.

Establishments with 250 or more employees and establishments in certain high-risk industries that have between 20-249 employees must submit their 300A summary form to OSHA via their website (https://www.osha.gov/injuryreporting/index.html) by March 2th. (See page 2 for more details)

*An establishment is "a single physical location where business is conducted or where services or operations are performed. For activities where employees do not work at a single physical location, such as construction[,] transportation[,] communications, electric, gas and sanitary services[,] and similar operations, the establishment is represented by main or branch offices, terminals, stations, etc.	

These criteria apply at the establishment level, not to your company as a whole. Establishments that meet any of the following criteria do not have to submit their information to OSHA.

- The establishment's peak employment during the previous calendar year was 19 or fewer, regardless of the establishment's industry.
- The establishment's industry is on this list, regardless of the size of the establishment.
- The establishment had a peak employment between 20 and 249 employees during the previous calendar year AND the establishment's industry is not on this list.
